THE CRISIS: Men who come to Providence Home are at a tipping point. Weary from their time in prison, treatment programs and homeless shelters, they face an uncertain future, ill-equipped to make healthy choices. A fractured social system further compounds the risk of relapse and return to prison.

THE NEED: New residents at Providence Home are eager to start a new life. Low self-esteem, shame, and hopelessness are pervasive feelings that cloud their minds. They need a caring team to come alongside them for wellness and accountability.

THE SOLUTION: Providence Home provides a structured, supportive environment for men to become financially, spiritually, emotionally, and physically stable. Each man lives in one of our residence halls in a dorm-style room and receives three meals per day. With safe, stabilized living conditions, our men can find meaningful employment and fully participate in our discipleship ministry. A new life, new relationships, and a new or renewed faith not only restores our men, but also strengthens their families and communities. Our hope is for each man to realize his full personal potential through a vital relationship with Jesus Christ.

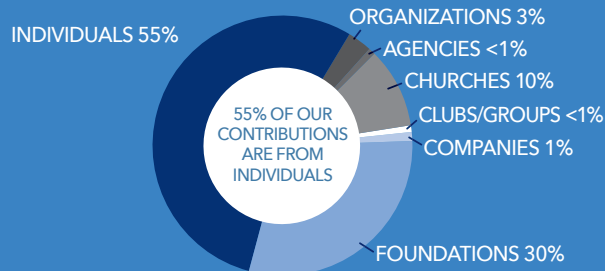

Life Changing Programs:

Men's Restoration Program

We provide a safe refuge for men where they experience recovery, restoration, and renewal through the power of Jesus Christ. Through our network of pastors, teachers, and counselors, our men are equipped to navigate a gospel-focused and biblically-based process of restoration.

Employment Assistance

Several key partners assist our men with resume building, certifications, employment searches, and placement assistance. As a result, our men find gainful employment that is rewarding.

Medical and Dental Care

Through our primary healthcare and dental care partnerships, men can address physical needs that have often been neglected for years. Our care services also include treatments for mental health and pharmaceutical needs.

Discipleship

The heart of restorative ministry happens through the involvement in a new healthy community that involves chapel, Bible studies, Christ-centered 12-step groups, and trauma-based recovery classes. The transformative truths learned are reinforced through one-on-one mentoring, counseling, and coaching.
